Father Damian celebrates 25 years

In his Homily on the night, Fr Damian, who has spent 11 years in the Ingham region, said it had been a blessing to serve the Lord and provide spiritual guidance to the community.

"I have been privileged to celebrate hundreds if not thousands of baptisms, to witness hundreds of marriages, and to confer the sacrament of confirmation, ordinarily the ministry of the Bishop, upon children and adults alike," he said.

And, of course, it has been a privilege and an honour to be present for so many families at that moment when the darkness of death has entered their lives and I have been able to offer them a small candlelight in the rites of Christian Burial.

"The priesthood, at the service of God and God's people, is an incredible gift of love from God to his church. Its origin is in him, it only has meaning if it is exercised for him, and its only purpose is to lead us to him."

Parishioner Pam Harris received a special mention from Fr Damian at the end of Mass for his Silver Jubilee, where Ms Harris was presented with the Bishop's Medallion for playing the organ for the parish for a remarkable 70 years.

"Thank you Pam for sharing your gifts with us," Fr Damian wrote in a Facebook post

"As Bishop Timothy J Harris wrote, "St Augustine said, 'He who sings once, prays twice'." You have multiplied the prayers of the faithful for many years through your service."
