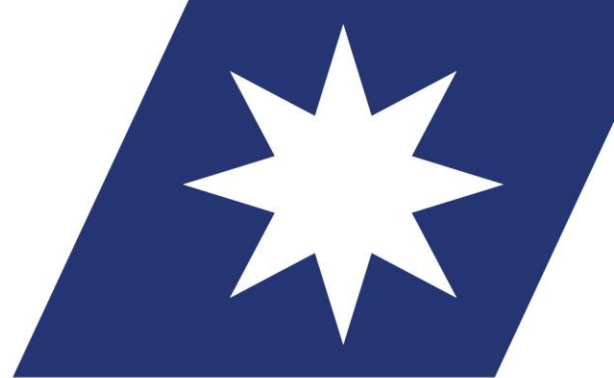

Katter to bring on vote to take back Australia

Bob Katter, Member for Kennedy, will be moving a motion in the Federal Parliament, when it returns, to reverse the decision to lease the Port of Darwin to the Chinese as well as the decision to hand the Chinese the water from the Ord River stage two and stage three.

The leader of the KAP said it's about time we woke up to ourselves and occupied our land mass.

"A people without land will search for a land without people," Mr Katter said.

"China might feel singled out but that's not the point. It's not anti-Chinese. It's against foreign ownership."

The long-serving Queensland MP is calling on fellow MPs in the house to defy the Government, whether ALP or LNP, grow a little bit of back bone and stand up.

"They are going to be made to vote on this and I promise every Member of Parliament - especially those from Queensland - that their local newspapers will write that he or she voted to keep the Port of Darwin and water from the Ord River in Chinese hands," Mr Katter said.

"Anyone that would give away their only 'non-coal loading' Panamax Port in the northern half of the continent to a foreign power has committed treason.

"We have no right to hold our country if we don't use it.

"We are not using it in any way, shape or form except to rape the mineral resources, and I use the word rape because we are getting little to no benefit out of those mineral resources.

"We get nothing out of the natural gas, which is now almost as big as coal."
