Katter Snapping at the Government's feet on Tourism

Last Friday at Cairns Wildlife Dome Bob Katter 'risked his life' flying in a harness only feet above a snapping 4.5 metre crocodile, to draw attention to the dire state of tourism in FNQ

Today the Kennedy MP met with Tourism Minister, Simon Birmingham, to put forward the case of FNQ tourism operators.

"They have called for BAS payments to be deferred," said Mr Katter.

"I've done my bit. I am calling on the Federal Government to do theirs."

Mr Katter said Coronavirus was only half the problem, as the industry had taken a 30% hit before flights from China were cancelled.

"I demand action on the Lilypad Left (Members of both Liberal and Labor) who are constantly bad mouthing what David Attenborough described as 'the most magical place on Earth' - Our Reef," Mr Katter said.

"What is the government doing to get the Grey Nomads back on the road and touring Australia?"

"The dollar is overvalued and interest rates have dropped to record lows so they have no retirement money to spend."
